Carpatair will operate all its 10 Romanian destinations as domestic flights

Timisoara, 14 March 2008 – All Carpatair flights within Romania will be operated as domestic flights starting 31 March. This was made possible mainly by the completion of modernization and extension work to the Timisoara Airport Terminal. This has optimized and rendered more efficient the passenger areas located in the domestic Departures / Arrivals area.

Until now, only passengers coming from Bucharest, Constanta, Craiova, Suceava, and Iasi, have been able to fly point-to-point to Timisoara with Carpatair. Starting 31 March, the same would apply to Carpatair passengers from Bacau, Cluj, Sibiu, Oradea, and Satu-Mare. These flights will thus allow a quick and easy transfer between Timisoara and any other destination operated by Carpatair in Romania and return and, to the same extent, the best international connections through the hub in Timisoara, thanks to the new “Domestic to International v.v. Quick Transfers Flows” facilities built on the purpose.

Carpatair operates regular flights from 10 Romanian destinations to 9 destinations in Italy – Turin, Milan, Verona, Venice, Ancona, Bologna, Florence, Bari, Rome –, 4 destinations in Germany – Munich, Stuttgart, Dusseldorf, Frankfurt am Main – and 2 in Greece – Athens, Thessaloniki (from 14 April). All flights operate with a short stop in Timisoara.
