11 Romanian cities just 3 hours away from Greece!

Timisoara, 08 February 2007 – From 27 March, Carpatair offers its passengers the possibility to travel from every corner of Romania to Athens, in less than three hours. Flights to and from Athens are scheduled three times a week, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Thus, no less than 10 cities in Romania (Bucharest, Constanta, Bacau, Iasi, Suceava, Cluj-Napoca, Sibiu, Oradea, Satu Mare, and Craiova) will be connected to Athens through the hub in Timisoara. Flight schedule will be as follows:
