From June, DIRECT FLIGHT TO KIEV!!!!

Timisoara, 21 April 2008 – From 2 June 2008, Carpatair enlarges its summer offer by opening up direct flights Bucharest-Kiev and Timisoara-Kiev.

From this date on, Carpatair passengers from Bucharest and Timisoara will benefit from direct flights to the capital of Ukraine three times a week, every Monday, Wednesday and Friday, according to the following schedule:

Bucharest-Kiev-Bucharest

Monday, Wednesday, Friday:

Bucharest – Kiev 20.00 - 21.40

Kiev – Bucharest 17.40 - 19.20

From 20 September, the Bucharest – Kiev – Bucharest flights will be operated daily except Saturdays, according to the same schedule.

Timisoara-Kiev-Timisoara

Monday, Wednesday, Friday:

Timisoara – Kiev 15.00 - 16.45

Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday:

Kiev – Timisoara 06.15 – 08.10

From 25 July, the Timisoara-Kiev-Timisoara flights will be operated on a daily basis, from Monday to Saturday included, according to the same schedule.

Moreover, the new flight Timisoara-Kiev and return will be linked to the entire network of Carpatair routes in Romania, so that the passengers from any Romanian town where we have flights (Constanta, Craiova, Bacau, Iasi, Suceava, Cluj-Napoca, Sibiu, Oradea, Satu Mare) will be able to fly to/from Kiev with a short stop in Timisoara.

In Ukraine, Carpatair operates scheduled flights to Lviv and Odessa (daily, from Monday to Saturday) and Kiev (from 2 June).

From 1 January 2008, Romanian citizens are allowed to travel to Ukraine without a visa. For the period of 90-day stay and for transiting, Ukraine annulled the obligation to hold a visa for the citizens belonging to the EU member states, Romania, Switzerland and Liechtenstein.
