## ODESSA: The second Ukrainian Carpatair destination

Timisoara, 24 January 2008 – Carpatair starts the New Year launching its second destination to Ukraine – Odessa. Thus, from 27 February, the whole Carpatair route network in Romania, Italy, Germany and Greece will be linked to the southeast part of Ukraine through the hub in Timisoara.

The new flight will be initially operated three times a week during 27 February – 25 March with a 50-seat Saab 2000 aircraft according to the following schedule:

Monday, Wednesday, Friday	Timisoara – Odessa:	15.15 – 16.45
Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday	Odessa – Timisoara:	06.45 – 08.15

Starting from 25 March, the flights will become daily, except for Sundays:

Monday – Saturday	Timisoara – Odessa:	15.15 – 16.45
Monday – Saturday	Odessa – Timisoara:	06.45 – 08.15

From our stations in Romania, Italy, Germany or Greece, Carpatair passengers will be able to travel to Odessa daily. The new flights have a maximum flexibility thanks to the operating schedule and the promotional prices. Carpatair issues electronic tickets on all its routes.

Starting 01 January 2008, Romanian citizens can travel to Ukraine without a visa. For periods of stay up to 90 days and for transiting, Ukraine has annulled the obligation to hold a visa for the citizens coming from the EU member states, Romania, Switzerland and Liechtenstein.
